







AIMS@JCU Pilot Research Funding Guidelines

AIMS@JCU Pilot Research funding awards will be distributed on a competitive basis and are subject to several criteria. Students will be assessed on:

- Quality of the proposed project
- The strength of the research linkage between AIMS and JCU
- Academic record and/or experience level of the student
- Inclusion of a component of quantitative analysis and/or modelling
- The maximum award will not exceed \$1,000

Students who are successful in receiving funds will be asked to provide information about the project and its progress for reports to the AIMS@JCU Management Committee as well as inclusion in the newsletter or website, and should be prepared to do so as a condition of support. Additionally, funded students must list AIMS@JCU as an affiliation for any publications or presentations resulting from the supported research.

Eligibility:

- AIMS@JCU student members at any level, excluding recipients of AIMS@JCU scholarships
- Nominated supervisors must be employed by the respective institutions
- All documentation to be received by AIMS@JCU by 3rd August 2018

To apply:

Application package requirements:

- 1) A completed application form
- Description of the proposed project which includes its relevance to AIMS@JCU and a description of how the project aligns with the AIMS strategic plan (not to exceed one page)
- 3) A statement indicating how the funds will be used (not to exceed 250 words)
- 4) Letters of support from supervisors at both parent institutions
- 5) Academic record
- 6) Curriculum vitae
