 - b. A short-written description of your activity with photographs to be used in the AIMS@JCU newsletter, website and/or other AIMS@JCU publications.

* In exceptional circumstances and on a case-by-case basis, the requirement for active student enrolment may be waived; for example, in the case of very recent candidature and a proposal to present results from that candidature. Contact aims@jcu.edu.au for further information.
